Who is Farm Service Elevator?

Farm Service Elevator is a commercial feed mill producing bulk feed for the poultry industry. The mill produces approximately 7,000 tons of feed per week, which is shipped out via bulk semis.

On a normal day FSE ships out approximately 55 truckloads between two loadout bays.

Addressing the Issues

FSE was having multiple issues with their overhead doors and as a result these issues were creating compliance infractions with Safe Quality Feed (SQF).
